Sec. 14-51 Permit (a), "No person shall make any opening, excavation or construct any walk, curb, pavement, driveway or perform any other construction work within, on, through or under any public street, highway or public right-of-way located in the city, including a state highway, for any purpose whatsoever, unless a permit has been obtained pursuant to this article from the director of public works or his designated agent. Any permit issued shall be valid for a period of ninety (90) days from the date thereof. Any work performed pursuant to such permit shall be subject to the approval by the director of public works or his designated representative. Said permit cost is \$50.00 for all excavations including the construction of a new driveway. Driveway replacement permit cost shall be \$25.00.

(b) On state highways located within the city, the city street opening permit must be obtained.- A \$25.00 City Street Opening Permit shall be required where a public sidewalk within a state right-of-way is impacted by the excavation. A no fee City Street Opening Permit is required in all other cases. This article does not supersede any regulations as set forth by the State Department of Transportation with regard to excavation in state highways.
