3.4 STOP SIGN REQUEST – HILLSIDE AT CORAM

MOVE TO FORWARD TO THE FULL BOARD PER THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO DENY THE REQUEST FOR A STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF CORAM AND HILLSIDE.

FURTHER, MOVE TO FORWARD THE FOLLOWING TO THE HIGHWAYS & BRIDGES DEPT. AND THE POLICE DEPT.

- **A LARGER WARNING SIGN WILL BE INSTALLED ON CORAM AVE SOUTHBOUND REPLACING THE EXISTING SMALL SIZED SIGN.**
- **A NEW “DO NOT ENTER” SIGN WILL BE MOUNTED ON THE REAR OF THE EXISTING “STOP” SIGN ON HILLSIDE AT CORAM**
- **A NEW “ONE WAY” ARROW SIGN WILL BE INSTALLED ON THE NORTHBOUND SIDE OF CORAM, SOUTH OF HILLSIDE, TO BETTER WARN MOTORISTS.**
- **TWO NEW CHEVRON SIGNS WILL BE INSTALLED ON CORAM TO BETTER MARK THE CURVE ON CORAM.**
- **THE TRAFFIC COUNTERS WILL BE SET UP ON CORAM AVE. TO SURVEY TRAFFIC SPEED AND VOLUME.**
- **INCREASE IN POLICE PATROLS IN THIS AREA.**
