1. AMENDMENT TO CODE OF ORDINANCES ARTICLE II.  
NAUGATUCK VALLEY COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS  
SECTION 12-16 THROUGH 12-19

**Article II. Naugatuck Valley Council of Governments**

12-16 City authorized to join.

The City of Shelton shall be a member of the **Naugatuck** Valley Council of Governments in accordance with Section 4-124i through 124p, inclusive, of the Connecticut General Statutes.

12-17 Mayor to represent City.

The representative of the City to the **Naugatuck** Valley Council of Governments shall be the Mayor.

12-18 Powers and duties.

The **Naugatuck** Valley Council of Governments shall have such power, purposes, responsibilities and duties as defined by the general statutes of the State.

12-19 Financial commitment.

Membership in the **Naugatuck** Valley Council of Governments shall in no way bind the City to any financial commitments or obligations except as may from time to time be provided by the annual budget. ~~meeting of the Board of Apportionment and Taxation.~~
