1. ETHICS CODE ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

2. BENEFIT FOR SURVIVING SPOUSES OF FIRE PERSONNEL

Whereas, the City of Shelton Fire Department consists of volunteer firefighters, and whereas, such volunteers are not paid employees of the City and whereas, such volunteers are exposed to the serious hazards of this duty, and whereas, it is the desire of the City to provide a tax abatement benefit to cover real estate and personal property taxes for a surviving spouse, now therefore be it Resolved that up to \$4,000 annually in real estate and personal property taxes of property owned by the surviving spouse of a Shelton fireman killed in the line of duty for the City of Shelton shall be abated during the period that the surviving spouse remains unmarried. Benefit will apply to current surviving spouses who otherwise qualify but the benefit will not be retroactive. This benefit does not apply to Shelton resident whom another municipality employs and who subsequently lose their life in the line of duty.
