

Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:15 pm.

Approval of minutes: A motion to approve the minutes of March 27, 2013 was made by Ron Pilkowicz, seconded by Ingrid Waters. All approved.

Adopt-a-Street: Ingrid's Adopt-a-Street signs disappeared some time around the blizzard. Possibly someone at Highways & Bridges has it. Otherwise, we will order a replacement.

Several new Adopt-a-Street signs are on order through Highways and Bridges, including signs for 1-800-MrJunker. Several members noted that the area on Long Hill Ave under the Route 8 bridge looks much nicer since that was adopted.

Clean Sweep: No one from the Housatonic River Clean-up has asked the City for a roll-off dumpster or port-o-let. There did not seem to be much publicity for the event in Shelton.

Mike said he was looking for a large project. Teresa suggested the removal of an old wrestling platform from the open space off of Pine Tree Hill Road. Mike will take a look at that.

Everyone agreed the new Clean Sweep road signs are quite visible around town.
