We have 18 members in our Precepting Program. Our new precepting team is working hard and providing exceptional training to our newest members.

We would like to congratulate our newest members to be cleared from training and now riding independently on the ambulance. We congratulate Sarah Castillo, Stephen Schwartz, Jesse Prajar, Morgan Brozena, and Alexandra Puglisi. We thank all of our members and staff who are acting as mentors and Field Training Officers.

**Training**

Echo Hose Ambulance provided hosted a free two-day state of Connecticut, Sex Trafficking Awareness (ToT) class. The purpose of the program was to help DCF identify and train instructors to help teach the material through the state.

Our next EMT course begins on June 25, 2018. For upcoming class details visit our web site [Http://www.echohose.com](http://www.echohose.com)

The Training Center will host the TEEX EOC Operations course in June. This is a certification program funded from FEMA and run by TEEX. This is open to all involved in emergency service and preparedness. It is a difficult course to get and we are pleased to be able to finally offer it locally. We encourage all to attend and sign up early as seating is limited.

The EHAC Community Training Center offers State EMT Testing twice a month and is running efficiently.

EHAC holds bi-monthly EMT refreshers and the training center.

We also continue to offer Community Access CPR/AED training on request.

Community Access to Narcan program has been ongoing. We are working with our community partners to schedule more public access events for the upcoming year.

Lt. Rob Fattibene and Training Officer Pat Lahaza have been offering monthly drills for continuing education for all our members and staff.

### **Equipment Update**

All Equipment and vehicles are in service.

### **Operations**

We recently added a dedicated 3rd ambulance on duty each weekday 0900-1700 to assist with the surge we often see during the weekdays. This additional resource is helping to cover the high demand of calls the service responds to during business hours.

Echo Hose Ambulance has placed a duty ambulance on standby in the area of Bridgeport Ave and Old Stratford Road weekdays from 9a-6pm. This car was strategically placed to be available to respond to areas where we are seeing consistent high call volume.

EHAC on duty crews and First Responders are on hand 24/7/365 with no first calls going to mutual aid services. EHAC's Paramedics are assisting on calls and mutual aid responses when needed.

## **Community Outreach**

On April 26<sup>th</sup>, EHAC had the opportunity to teach all 4<sup>th</sup> graders at Elizabeth Shelton School "Hands Only" CPR.

On May 24<sup>th</sup> Echo Hose Ambulance spent the day teaching all 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students from Elizabeth Shelton School in First Aid. The children all were sent home with a First Aid Kit and the supplies they learned to use during the class. We would like to thank the ESS PTO for donating the money to purchase the First Aid kits to distribute to the children.

On May 22<sup>nd</sup> & May 23<sup>rd</sup>, the EHAC Team visited Shelton Intermediate School and trained all graduating seniors (approximately 350 students) to recognize a cardiac arrest event and how to perform "Hands Only" CPR. This was a fantastic event and we are proud to report that almost 550 children were taught First Aid and/or CPR in less than one month in the City of Shelton. We thank all our members who volunteered to participate in the programs.

The new training center located on the St. Joseph's Campus hosted its first community training program. The facility was used by the Shelton Youth Service Bureau who held a program education over 20 local teens about the dangers of vaping.

We are also now partnered with Shelton Empowers with our very own Asst. Chief Joe Laucella as its Chairperson. This group focuses on helping youth and others in our community with every day challenges including the risks of drug and alcohol abuse.

## **MRC**

The Medical Reserve Corps is a statewide program that Echo Hose Ambulance and the Naugatuck Valley Health District has partnered together to establish for this area. The MRC prepares members of our team to help in the time of disaster. The MRC would help staff and coordinate mass dispensing of medications, vaccinations, sheltering and rehabilitation of residents and emergency workers in the Naugatuck Valley. 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Commissioners,

The following is the Shelton Fire Department – Chief’s Report for the month of May 2018. This is a list of completed tasks and a short list of those tasks and projects in progress.

**Apparatus:**

- 1) Rescue 45 placed OOS, and is currently at Tracy’s Garage to begin removal of rescue body for prep for new cab and chassis
- 2) New ATV - Ranger # 5 is currently at Fire Maintenance Facility receiving outfitting, and new operator training has been scheduled.
- 3) DOT and Pump Testing ongoing.
- 4) Tower 7 has been relocated to Company # 4, and placed in reserve status due to apparatus floor issues at Echo Hose.
- 5) Squad 1 has been relocated to the Fire Apparatus Maintenance facility due to apparatus floor issues at Echo Hose.
- 6) Utility Truck 9 OOS at Tracy’s Garage for Engine turbo repairs.

**Staff Assignments/Projects:**

- 1) Currently, still in a holding pattern, in regard to HFC # 3 renovations Bid 38-12 and awaiting action of scheduling interviews for Echo Hose Bid # 38-11. The next step will be to acquire funding from BOA & Mayor to move the conceptual design process forward.

- 2) Chief Jones, still awaiting updated written information from engineering firm in regard to Echo Hose Floor issue, Squad 1 was relocated to FAM facility, and Tower 7 & Engine 24 to Company # 4. Verbal approval has been given to Building Maintenance Chris Potucek by Mayor Lauretti to move forward with engineering plans for floor replacement and repair of floor.
- 3) Contingency plans for Echo Hose apparatus movement has been discussed, best short term scenario is to use 40 Riverdale Ave – which is the city owned FD Maintenance and Bus Repair facility, during summer months while repairs being completed on Echo HQ Floor.
- 4) Chief Jones, and the fire company honor guards attended the annual Memorial Day Remembrance Ceremony at Shelton High School.
- 5) Chief Jones & Chairman Maglione met over the course of the month to discuss department policies for BOFC's to review, and to move forth the approved Pre Planner Position to the BOFC's for interview and selection of a candidate.
- 6) Deputy Chief Hongo continues to work with Griffin Hospital Occupational Medication on our Respiratory Protection and Medical Monitoring Program. Any and all issues should be forwarded to DC Hongo. (on-going)
- 7) Deputy Chief Hongo continues to work on procedures to further reduce our membership to Carcinogens. This will include recommendations for positive diesel exhaust capture systems, additional washer/drying units, enhanced cleaning procedures of equipment, and gear procedures. (in process)
- 8) Deputy Chief Hongo is working on establishing a Peer Support Program and acquiring a EAP Program for the SFD membership (in process)
- 9) Staff updating our former MSDA Program, to new SDS Standards.(nearing completion)

#### **Training: Assistant Chief Wilson**

- 1) I-2 Policy & OSHA Required Training (In progress)
- 2) New firefighter orientation (in progress)
- 3) Rope Rescue Training (completed)
- 4) Mental Health First Aid Course (Postponed, lack of interested members)
- 5) Walk through planned at construction site of new assisted living building on Beard Saw Mill Road (TBD)
- 6) New AVT Driver training being planned for June
- 7) 2 - SFD Members successfully graduated from the CFA Recruit Course on May 23rd

Incidents included (2) structure fires, (1) Extrication, (1) partial building collapse with no entrapment, (4) cooking fires, (2) Marine Unit Response, (12) MVA's, (6) MVA's on Route 8 and responded as a task force to Brookfield CT to assist with search and rescue over a 24 hour period due to damage caused from a Macro Burst and Tornadoes effecting portion of CT on May 14<sup>th</sup>. The fire department also responded to number of calls during the storms aftermath in Shelton. Including homes being struck by tree, and one vehicle extrication.
