STREET COMMITTEE MOTIONS– AUGUST 3, 2004

Call to Order / Pledge of Allegiance

Alderman Stan Kudej called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m. All those present rose and pledged allegiance to the flag.

Roll Call - Street Committee

Alderman Kenneth Olin – Arrived late 7:20pm
Alderman Stanley Kudej – present
Alderwoman Lynne Farrell – present

Alderman Jack Finn – present in audience

There was a quorum of 3 present

Public Session –

Mr. Lawrence Iannucci spoke regarding the Pawtucket paper street. All the different departments told him this is where he had to start. He provided map and plans for the subdivision he plans to build.

Alderman Kudej closed the public session at 7:30pm

Alderwoman Farrell moved to add item 2.6 City Abandonment & Conveyance of Excess Right-of-way to Adjacent Property Owners on Mohegan Road to the Agenda. Seconded by Alderman Kudej. A voice vote was taken and the motion PASSED 3-0

Approval of Minutes

Alderman Kudej MOVED to recommend to the full Board to waive the reading of and approve the minutes of the June, 2004 Street Committee meeting; SECONDED by Alderman Olin. A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 3-0.

NEW BUSINESS**2.1 First Ward – Underbrush Removal**

Alderman Finn addressed the Committee with respect to the overgrowth of underbrush through out the City. Alderman Olin said he had spoken to the Mayor about this problem and that they had driven out to inspect the White Hills area.

Alderman Olin thought that this work had been done. He will talk to the Mayor again and find out why the trees are not being cut back / down.

2.2 Intersection of Buddington Road & Judson Street

Alderman Kudej MOVED to forward to the City Engineer for review and recommendation. Further move to forward to Planning and Zoning Commission for an 8-24 referral. SECONDED by Alderman Olin. A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 3-0.

Alderman Finn Spoke with regard to this intersection.

2.3 Pawtucket Avenue – Street Extension

Alderman Kudej moved to forward to the Planning & Zoning Commission for an 8-24 refferal, Inland Wetland Commission & the City Engineer for review and recommendation. Seconded by Alderman Olin. A voice vote was taken and Motion PASSED 3-0.

Mr. Iannucci spoke during the public portion.

2.4 Relocation of Easement

Alderman Kudej moved to forward to the Planning & Zoning Commission for an 8-24 referral and to the City Engineer for review and recommendation. Seconded by Alderman Olin. A voice vote was taken and the Motion PASSED 3-0.

Mr. Ted Postupak addressed the Committee with regard to a drainage pipe across his property. He referred to maps from 1956. Alderman Olin Said that he & Alderman Kudej would come see the property. Mr. Postupak would like the City to have an easement so that they can fix the pipe. He has many sink holes in his property from the water that runs underneath this pipe.

2.5 Woods Grove

Alderman Olin spoke with Bill Mooney about this street. Bill reported that they had fixed the drainage problem and repaved that section of the street. Alderman Olin stated that the rest of the road will be repaved at a later date.

2.6 City Abandonment & Conveyance of Excess Right-of-way to Adjacent Property Owners on Mohegan Road

Alderman Kudej moved to forward to the Full Board per the recommendation of the planning & Zoning Commission to approve the City Abandonment & Conveyance of excess right-of-way to adjacent property owners located on Mohegan Road. Seconded by Alderman Olin. A voice vote was taken and the motion PASSED 3-0.

3.0 Old Business

3.1 KKAD25 – June update from Dennis Kelly

Alderman Olin said they had discussed this with Mayor Lauretti and that they had agreed it would be ok for Dennis to put up some signs. There was no further action.

3.2 Daybreak Lane

A call was received by the Clerk regarding the sightline at Daybreak Lane, Per this person(would not give name) the grass had only been cut back to the guard rail not to the fence. Alderman Olin would like the Clerk to send a memo to Bill Mooney for an update of the work that has been done. Has the brush been cut back to the fence?

3.3 Left Turn Lane Huntington Street

After some discussion, Alderman Olin moved to recommend to the Full Board to override & deny the Planning & Zoning favorable 8-24 referral and recommendation from the City Engineer for a left hand turn off of Huntington Street into Blueberry Lane. Seconded by Alderman Kudej. A voice vote was taken and the motion passed 3-0
