Call to Order

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Alderman Street Committee was called to order at 6:00 pm in Room 104 of Shelton City Hall, by Chairman Alderman McPherson on Tuesday June 5, 2012.

Public Portion:

Chris Tebbit of 23 Woonsocket Road addressed the committee. He is seeking to have his road repaved and a large pot hole filled.

Mr. DiMauro said the pot hole would not be a problem, you can just call Highways and Bridges and they will go out and fix it but repaving will take some scheduling but they will review it and see where Woonsocket is on the list.

Minutes for Approval

Alderman Kudej made a motion to wave the reading of the minutes from the April 2012 meeting and approve them.

The motion was second by Alderman Farrell. The motion carried.

New Business

2.1 Mr. DiMauro gave a recap of what had been completed over the winter, There had been five different projects. Highways and Bridges took on putting in conduit for AT&T lines and they did it for less than half of what AT&T wanted. They worked on the parks trail, cleared out the spot where the new dog pound should be going, cleaned out sewers, etc. They started the paving process and Fairmount Place is done.

Mr. DiMauro went over some projects that will be started and or completed over the summer. There was some discussion amongst the committee and Mr. DiMauro about priorities and which streets should be done in which order.

Old Business

3.1 Garbage Issue:

Letters will be going out to violators of the Garbage Ordinance. The Ordinance is being tweaked to be cleaner and a mass letter will be sent out to everyone over four units about the program going into place.

There was some discussion on how the program will affect business and apartments.

There will be places that are grandfathered in but they will be changing the language in the Ordinance so that new properties as of July 1st would not have their garbage collected.

There are rules regarding how long the garbage can stay out and how many hours in advance it can be put out. Mr. DiMauro explained the components of the new Garbage/Recycling Ordinance.

There was discussion on this.

Reports – Street Committee Members

Alderman Kudej commented there are over hang issues with trees and brush growing that need to be taken care of as quickly as possible.

Alderman McPherson commented that the Folley Avenue open space property boulders have been moved and need to be moved back. The same thing also needs to be done at Riverview.

Alderman Kudej made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was second by Alderman Farrell.
