

Shelton Summer Playground Program

2009 Season

The Shelton Parks and Recreation Department will begin its **2009 Playground Season** for Shelton residents only on Monday, June 29, 2009 at 10:00 am for Shelton residents. The 6 playground locations are Booth Hill School, Lafayette School, Mohegan School, Sunnyside School, Pine Rock Park off Long Hill Avenue and White Hills Recreation Building at 3 School Street on the corner of East Village Road. **Due to field renovations at Long Hill School children are relocated to Pine Rock Park. Due to roof replacement at Elizabeth Shelton School children are relocated to the White Hills Recreation Building.**

The playgrounds will be open each **Monday 10:00 am – 3:00 pm and Tuesdays through Friday from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm.** The program will run for **6 weeks beginning Monday, June 29, 2009 and end on Friday, August 7, 2009.** Closed on July 3rd and rainy days. Children spending the entire day should bring their lunches.

Registration at each playground will take place throughout opening week and is open for all children **6 – 14 years of age.** It is important that parents inform the Playground Supervisors of any medical history of their children that might require immediate or emergency attention, such as allergies to insect or bee stings.

During registration week, the children should sign up for the Playground Special Programs. Field trips during the Playground Season will take place and will be announced weekly. Included in the field trips will be selected movies, roller-skating and swimming programs. Arts and Crafts will be offered to each playground throughout the season. A small fee will be collected to cover cost of materials. Activity sheets will be posted each Monday to inform the children of the calendar of events for each week.
