



Chromium Process Demolition and Remediation Project

This is to advise the public, downtown Shelton businesses, and residents that the long awaited demolition project for the former Chromium Process building has commenced. The City of Shelton has awarded the contract for the services necessary to complete this project.

The official Notice to Proceed to the contractor, Standard Demolition, was issued effective August 8, 2016. The demolition contractor has sixty (60) working days (three months) to complete this activity.

The first month of work will largely take place on the inside of the building. That will be followed by the demolition of the building and related environmental cleanup activities. The City does not anticipate closing any roads; however, for certain periods during the actual demolition project, the contractor may be allowed to reduce traffic to one lane.

The Shelton Economic Development Corporation is managing the daily activities at the site and engineering supervision and environmental services are being provided by AECOM. Project updates are going to be posted every two weeks on the SEDC website site located at sheltonedcorp.org and monthly at the Valley Independent Sentinel valley.newhavenindependent.org.
