

## **Replacement of Waverly Road Bridge Public Information Meeting**

The City of Shelton is planning to replace the Waverly Road Bridge over the Farmill River, which was constructed in 1936 and is functionally obsolete. This bridge replacement project would receive funding from the state Local Transportation Capital Improvement Program (LOTICIP).

On Wednesday October 5, 2016 at 7:00 p.m., the City of Shelton will conduct a Public Information Meeting on this project at the Shelton Community Center, which is located at 41 Church Street (Craft Room #2, Second Floor). It is the City's and the State's policy to keep persons informed and involved when such projects are undertaken.

The cost of the bridge replacement would be reimbursed 100% from the state LOTICIP funding.
