RESIDENTIAL BRUSH PICK – UP

If Residents have the ability to dispose of brush yourself, we urge you to do so. The Shelton Transfer Station, located at 866 River Road is open from 7:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Monday thru Saturday and is free to all Shelton Residents.

For residents that require assistance, beginning the week of August 17th the Public Works Department will be picking up resident's brush that was a result of tropical storm Isaias only.

The following restrictions must be adhered to:

- 1) Items must be placed neatly curbside, we will not enter anyone's property.**
- 2) Brush must be placed with butt end facing the street, and be no longer than 6 feet in length.**
- 3) Limbs must be no larger than 12 inches in diameter and 6 feet in length.**
- 4) No stumps will be picked up.**

If the above restrictions are not adhered to, you will be passed over and we will not return.

Please call the Public Works Dept. (203) 924-9277 when your brush is at the Curb.

As we have extensive tree damage Citywide, this will be a prolonged process. We urge you to have patience in our getting to you- please call only one time.
