Said Bids will then be opened and read aloud publicly on Thursday, October 11, 2018 at 3:00 pm. in City Hall Room 104 for supplying the City of Shelton with:

Plans, Specifications and Bid Proposal Forms may be obtained at the Office of the City Engineer, 54 Hill Street, Shelton, CT, Tuesday through Friday between 8:00 am. and 5:30 p.m. upon payment of thirty dollars (\$30.00) for each set. Said payment shall be refunded to contractors who return the bid documents in good condition. The scope of work consists of the installation of a three-cell precast concrete box culvert with concrete wingwalls, roadway reconstruction, as well as the related appurtenant work.

**CONTRACTOR SHALL BE PRE-QUALIFIED BY THE CONNECTICUT DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION FOR GROUP NO. 8 --- MINOR BRIDGES CONSTRUCTION**

Each bid shall be signed by the bidder and accompanied by a certified check made payable to the Treasurer of the City of Shelton for five percent (5%) of the amount Bid, or a Bid Bond designating the City of Shelton as obligee, for five percent (5%) of the amount Bid. Said checks or bonds shall be returned to the unsuccessful bidders, and to the successful bidder or bidders, if any, awarded the contract upon submitting a Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price. The Contract and Bond must be executed within ten (10) days after notification by the Purchasing Agent of the acceptance of the bid. No bidder may withdraw his/her bid within ninety (90) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

THIS CONTRACT IS SUBJECT TO STATE SET-ASIDE AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

Each bid must contain the executed Non—Collusion Affidavit and have the completed Bid Submission Label affixed to the bid envelope submitted. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids in whole or in part, or to waive any informality or technicalities in the bids received. No obviously unbalanced bid will be considered in awarding this contract. Any award relative to this solicitation will be subject to the availability of funds.
